
STATE OF ARIZONA ★ PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Arizona farmers are committed to ensuring their crops are safe and have come together to establish a standardized food safety program; and
WHEREAS, Arizona's continued commitment to providing consumers with the safest leafy greens possible includes ongoing research-based improvements to growing and harvesting leafy greens; and
WHEREAS, Arizona farmers are invested in a food safety education and training program to share knowledge and ensure compliance within the leafy greens industry; and
WHEREAS, Arizona consistently produces an abundance of nutritious and safe leafy greens.
NOW, THEREFORE, I, Douglas A. Ducey, Governor of the State of Arizona, do hereby proclaim November 2021 as

ARIZONA LEAFY GREENS MONTH


and call upon all residents to reflect upon and recognize the Arizona leafy greens industry during the month of November.
